You could watch something you are growing yourself or use the time lapse.</p>	<p>ICT</p> <p>Using a photo app, like Pic Collage, can you make a poster about something. It could be signs of summer/e-safety/ your pet. Remember to include photos, text, a background, stickers that match the topic.</p> <p>You could save it as a jpeg and upload it to your dojo portfolio</p>	<p>Physical</p> <p>Choose some of the speaking and listening activities from the PDF pack, up-loaded with the grid, to try.</p> <p>Choose some skills from Footy Pups to try https://www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/shows/footy-pups</p> <p>You could watch the video first and then have a go at different one.</p> <p>Make up your own game. What will the rules be? What will you need to play? How will you know who has won?</p>	<p>PHSE</p> <p>Try and do one random act of kindness each week. This could be helping to do the washing up, making a card for loved ones you can't see or even donating to a food bank. It can even be as simple as smiling at people you pass when you're out doing your daily exercise. Afterwards think about how it made you feel?
