## **SCHOOL CLOSURE 9<sup>th</sup> OCTOBER 2020**

Dear Parents/ Carers,

Thank you for your prompt response to come and collect your children earlier today.

The reason for our schools closing was due to both schools having no running water, leaving the children and staff unable to flush the toilets, wash their hands or fill up water bottles. As a result, both headteachers and governing bodies, alongside Warwickshire County Council, made the decision to close early as it was not feasible to continue education safely at school.

Severn Trent have since informed us that there is a burst water main in Rugby which they are trying to fix currently. This is unlikely to be resolved before 4pm. However, we do not anticipate that it will affect children's return to school on Monday.

Should you need further clarification of any aspect of the above, please do not hesitate to speak to either headteacher. Meanwhile, on behalf of the governors, may we take this opportunity to thank you for supporting our policies and procedures and ensuring the safe departure of all pupils.

We look forward to seeing everyone again on Monday 12<sup>th</sup>.
