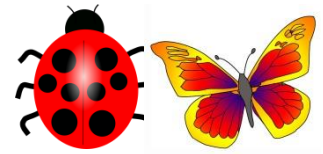




Reception News - October 2016

Remember to change your child's reading book regularly. Please ask any member of staff if you are unsure where these are kept.

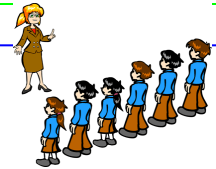


Class assemblies
