

# Evaluating your Mars Rover

Think carefully about what worked and what went wrong with your design. If you were to make the model again, what could you change or improve? Think about which techniques worked and which ones didn't.

Try to think about:

- Materials-
  - Were they easy to make into the shapes you wanted? (flexible or rigid?)
  - Which materials worked best? (plastic, card, paper, fabric, metal or something else?)
  - Would you choose different materials next time? Why?
- Joining-
  - How did you join the parts of your Mars Rover? (sellotape, string, glue, paperclips, staples, treasury tags, split pins?)
  - Were the parts easy or difficult to join? Why? (weight, texture, type of join)
  - Could you have joined parts together a different way?
- Movement-
  - Did you get your Mars Rover to move? Why/why not?
  - What made it easy/difficult to get it to move?
