Greater Than or Less Than Game

Instructions

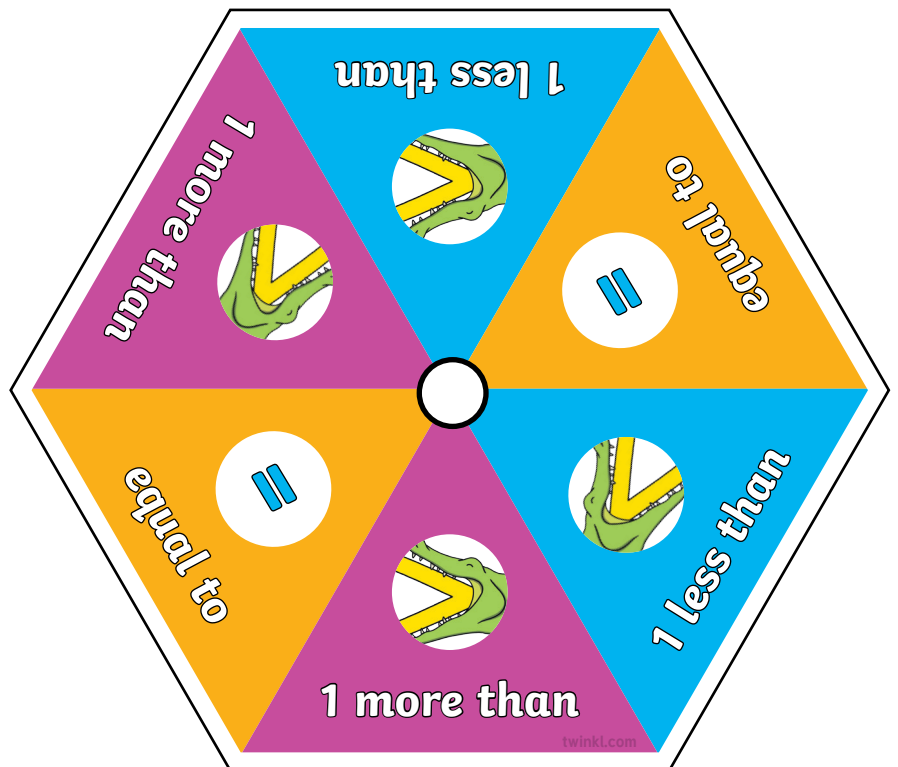
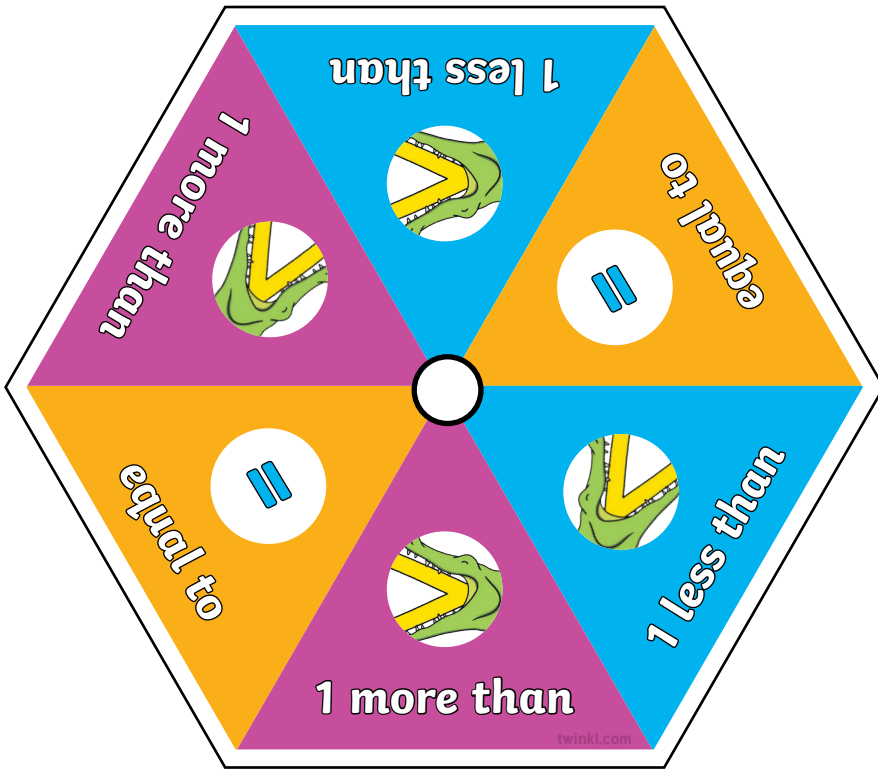
This is a game for 2 players.

You Will Need:

- 1 game board per player
- 8 counters
- 20 interlocking cubes (optional, as a concrete resource)
- 1 pack of 0-20 cards (not included)
- 1 spinner
- 1 pencil

How to Play:

1. Each player needs a game board. Spread the 0-20 cards face down over the table.
2. Player 1 turns over a card and, if using cubes, builds a tower with that many cubes.
3. Player 2 turns over a card and, if using cubes, builds a tower with that many cubes.
4. The player with the taller tower spins the spinner.
5. Each player finds what is **one more than**, **one less than** or **equal to** their number.
6. If that number appears on their game board, they cover it with a counter and say a sentence about that number. For example, "8 is one less than 9".
7. Both players then turn over another card to find two more numbers and build two more towers.
8. The first to cover all the numbers on the game board is the winner.

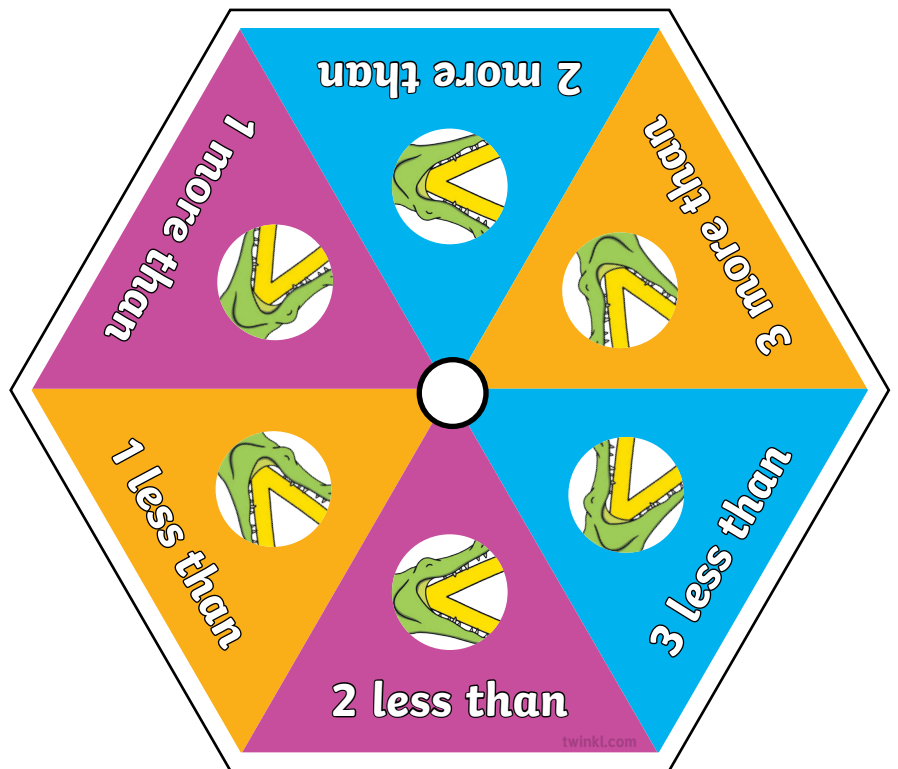
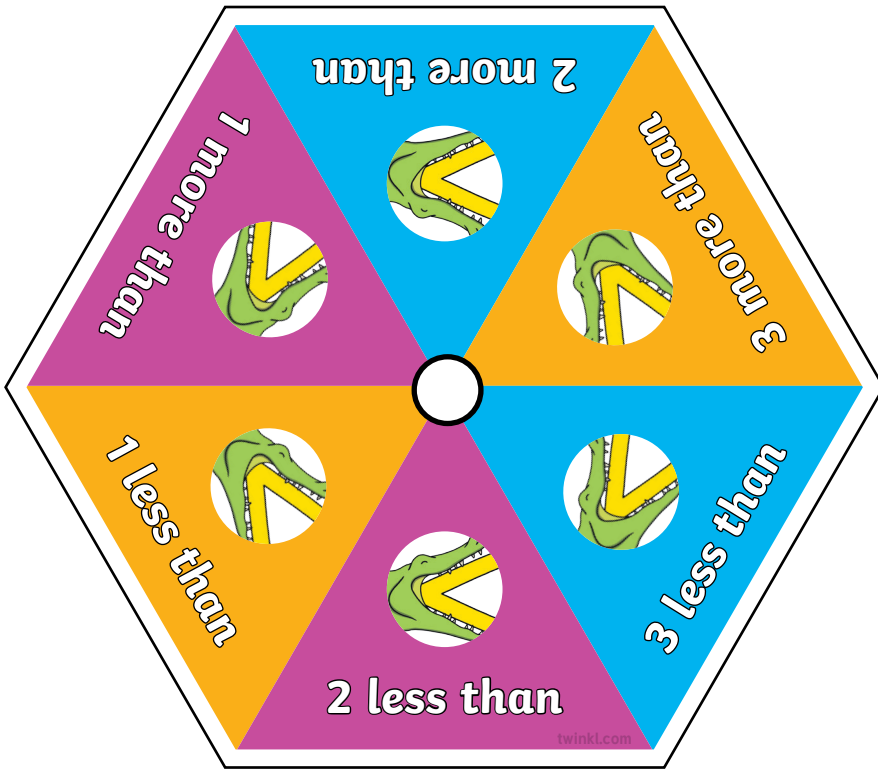
This is a game for 2 players.

You Will Need:

- 40 interlocking cubes (optional, as a concrete resource)
- 1 pack of 0-20 cards (not included)
- 1 spinner
- 1 pencil

How to Play:

1. Each player needs a game board. Spread the 0-20 cards face down over the table.
2. Player 1 turns over a card and, if using cubes, builds a tower with that many cubes.
3. Player 2 turns over a card and, if using cubes, builds a tower with that many cubes.
4. The player with the taller tower spins the spinner.
5. Each player finds what is **1, 2 or 3 more than**, or **1, 2 or 3 less than** their number, depending on what the spinner shows.
6. If that number appears on their game board, they cover it with a counter and say a sentence about that number. For example, "8 is two less than 10".
7. Both players then turn over another card to find two more numbers and build two more towers.
8. The first to cover all the numbers on the game board is the winner.

Greater Than or Less Than Game

Instructions

This is a game for 2 players.

You Will Need:

- 1 game board per player
- 8 counters
- 1 pack of 0-20 cards (not included)
- 1 spinner
- 1 pencil

How to Play:

1. Each player needs a game board. Spread the 0-20 cards face down over the table.
2. Player 1 turns over a card.
3. Player 2 turns over a card. Together, the children should work out **whose number is greater** and the **difference** between the numbers.
4. A player then spins the spinner.
5. If the spinner lands on the > sign, the player who has the larger number can fill in one box on their game board. For example, if > is spun and Player 1 has **8** and Player 2 has **2**, Player 1 writes

$$8 > 2$$

8 is 6 more than 2

6. If the spinner lands on the < sign, the player who has the smaller number fills in the box on their game board.
7. Both players then turn over another card to find two more numbers and continue the game, taking turns to spin the spinner.
8. The first to complete all four boxes on their game board is the winner.
