KEY SKILLS

ENGLISH

To deliver an engaging English curriculum which equips our children with the skills they need to become effective communicators, enabling them to access the wider curriculum.

Throughout the school, we aim to promote a culture which values language in all its forms and promotes enjoyment.

We do this by:

- Teaching systematic, synthetic phonics (Letters and sounds).
- Talk for Learning.
- Writing for different purposes.
- Explicit teaching of handwriting and spelling, punctuation, grammar and vocabulary.
- Reading for purpose and pleasure.

MATHS

To deliver an engaging Mathematics curriculum which ensures our children become fluent in the fundamentals of maths, know and can confidently apply key skills and reason mathematically.

We provide opportunities for our children to develop these skills through:

- Daily mental maths
- Discrete teaching of new concepts.
- Allowing our children to learn and apply different methods of solving problems.
- Application of skills and concepts independently.
- Reasoning
- Developing and promoting a love of maths through exploration in continuous provision and embedding skills across the curriculum.
